*Truly a work of art*, this beautiful home sits atop a sloping hillside. Built to capture the majestic view of the nearby countryside, main living areas are located on the upper level. Ground level access is available at the front side of the home through a wide main entry.

Arched openings provide a grand entrance into the dining room and living room. A series of French doors line the wall, facing the veranda, giving a full view of the landscape beyond.

The living room is illuminated with natural light cascading through dormer windows and embraced by a high-beamed ceiling. The sunlight beautifully accents the large masonry fireplace with a wet bar featured on one side. A set of double doors on the side will lead to a study.

On the other side of the fireplace, a broad archway leads past the stairwell to the master suite. The master bedroom is complemented by a stylishly elegant bathroom layout and also features a double-wide closet. Exquisite French doors open to the veranda.

Across the veranda is the spacious family room and kitchen area with high-vaulted ceilings and ample glass accents. A private passageway, adjacent to the kitchen, adjoins to the dining room. The passage allows access to the laundry room as well as a second stairway leading to the lower level garage.

Two bedrooms sharing a common bath are located on the lower level, in addition to a large game room. A multi-purpose room serving as a home office or another bedroom is also included in the floor plans. A patio below the main level veranda is easily accessible from all areas.
