The Normandy

Truly a wonderful place to call home,

Lovely curved dormers with copper roofs give symmetry to the front of the home and draw attention to the long covered porch sheltering the main entry. Wide shutters in the European tradition flank the main doors and the double French doors along the porch. Inside a formal entry opens on one side to a large great room with a timber-trimmed ceiling, a magnificent cast stone fireplace, and wide French doors opening to a sheltered side yard.

Across is a formal dining room that includes a butler's pantry large enough for its own sink and icemaker, as well as access to a generous kitchen pantry.

An enormous combination kitchen/family room greets guests and family on less formal occasions. The kitchen has a large center island and abundant counter space while the deep breakfast nook sparkles with sunlight streaming through its banked windows. One set of French doors

opens the family room to a pleasant side yard and invites al fresco dining in warm weather. In cooler months, a cozy fireplace and built-in entertainment center are welcomed beneath the room's timbered ceiling.

The master bedroom is private and located at the back of the home in its own wing. Two sets of French doors open onto the side yard and tall windows in the European tradition welcome even more sunlight into this beautiful space. The master bath has a vanity with knee space, a separate shower, a private water closet and a whirlpool tub encased in stone. The master closet is generous with long reaches of hanging space, several banks of adjustable shelves and a built-in wardrobe.

Upstairs are two more quiet bedrooms with clipped ceilings, full bath, linen closet and large walk-in closets. The loft and large bonus room are a perfect space for an additional office or bedroom.
